Regional average earnings per job are **\$13.3K below** the national average earnings of \$65.7K per job.

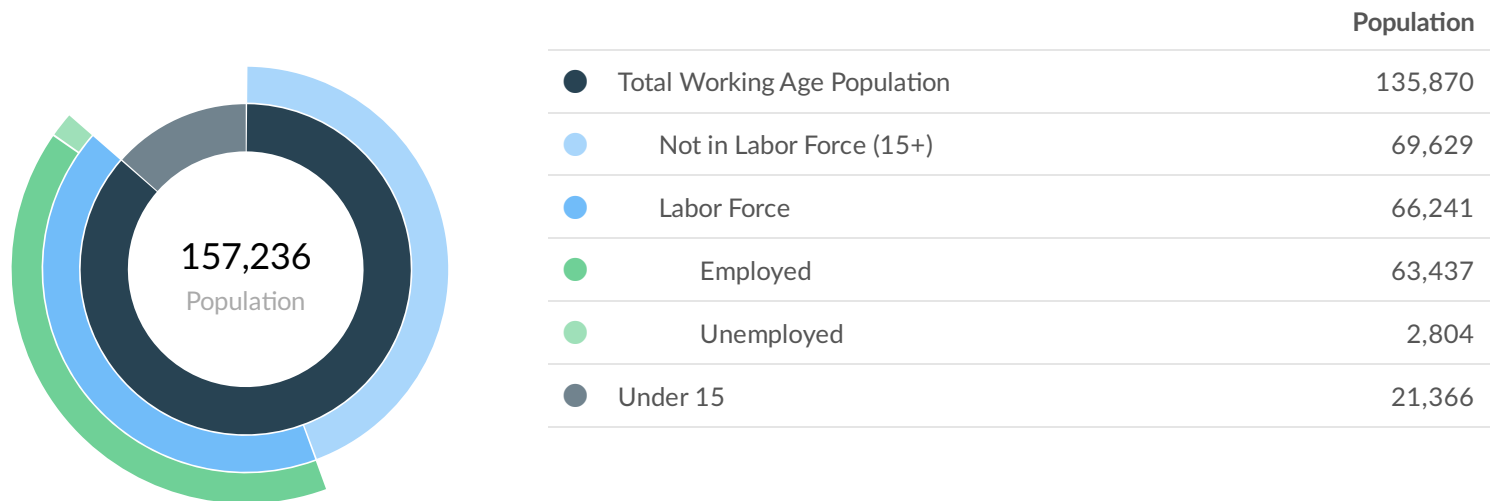
## Takeaways

- As of 2018 the region's population **increased by 1.9%** since 2013, growing by 2,967. Population is expected to **increase by 1.8%** between 2018 and 2023, adding 2,766.
- From 2013 to 2018, jobs **increased by 10.7%** in CSEDD from 48,432 to **53,598**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 8.2% by 2.5%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 48.5% to 48.8% between 2013 and 2018**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.7% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.0% below the national average), and **10.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2018 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

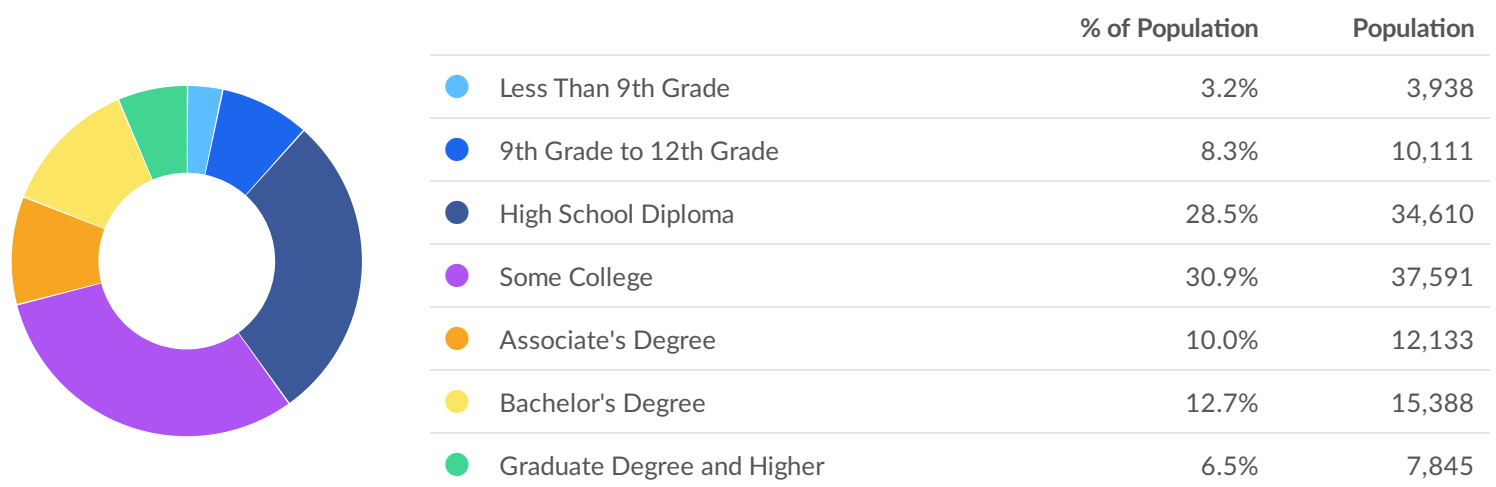

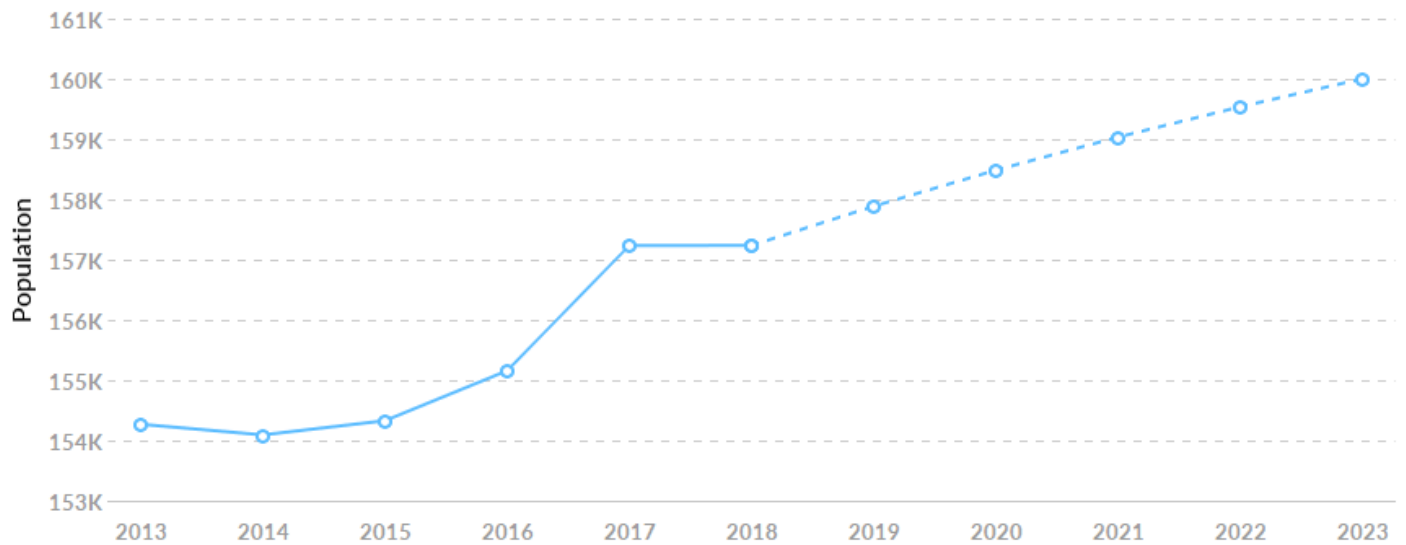

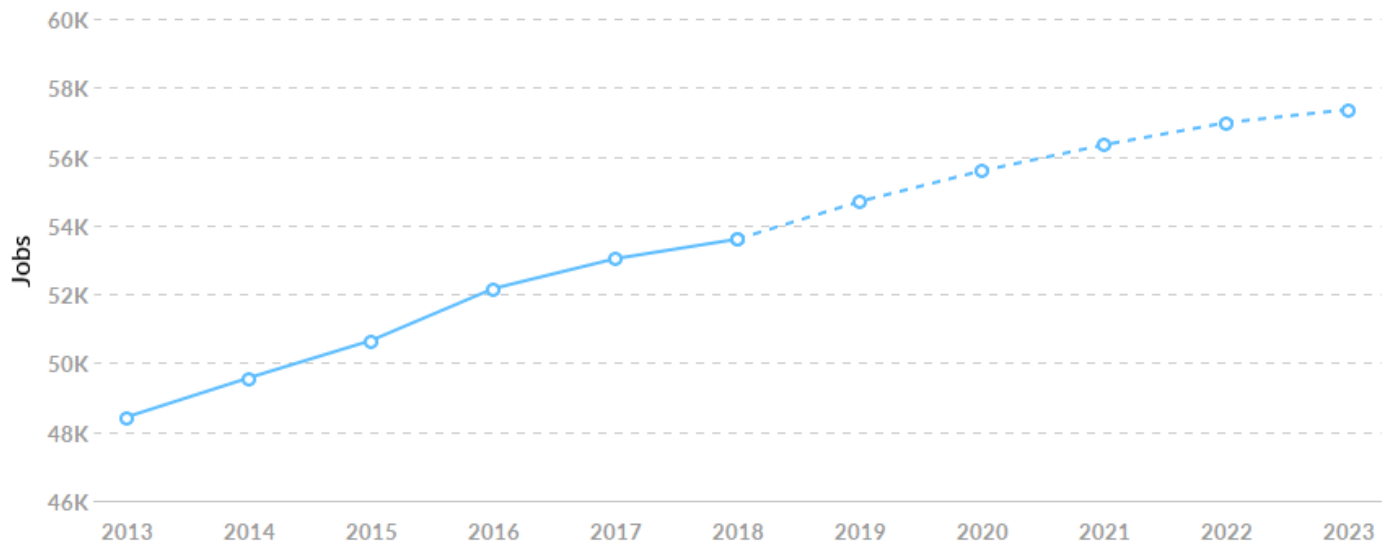

### Job Trends

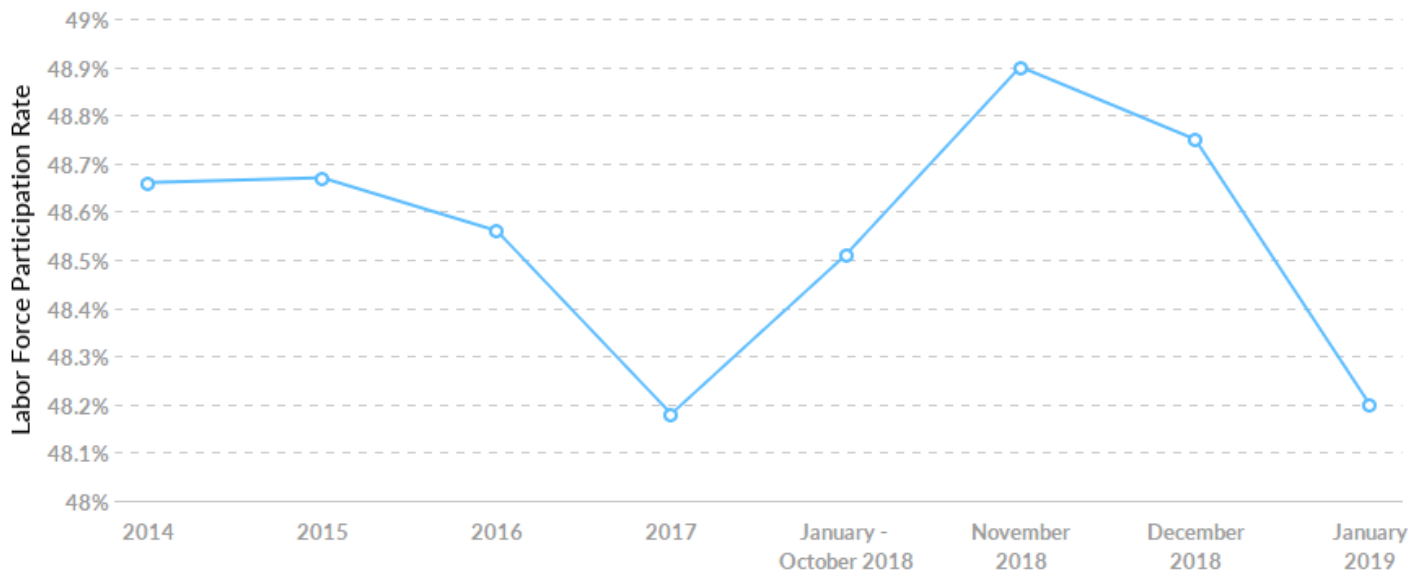

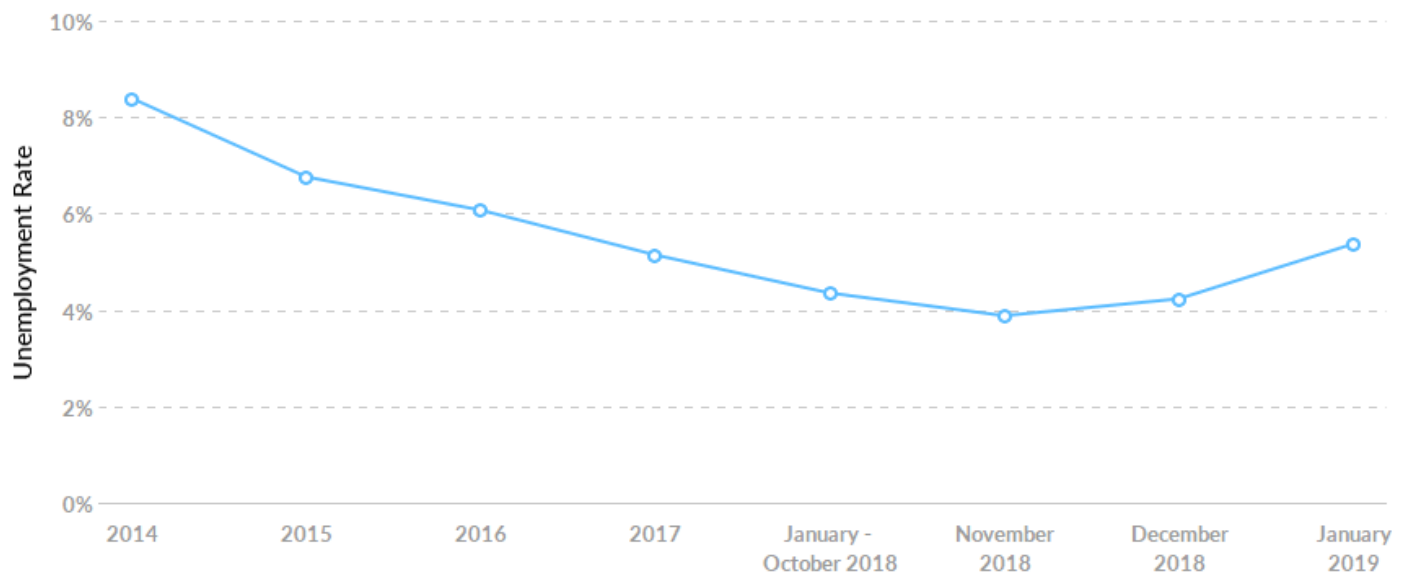

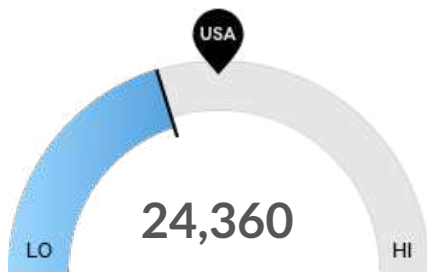

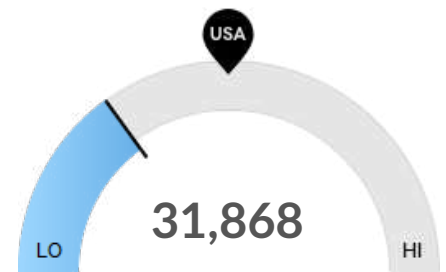
**Millennials**

Your area has 24,360 millennials (ages 20-34). The national average for an area this size is 32,566.



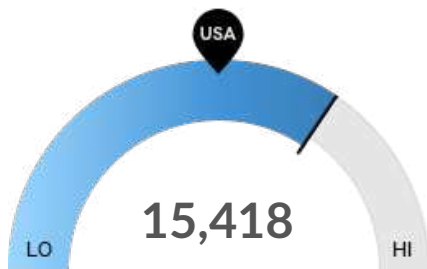
**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in your area. The national average for an area this size is 44,824 people 55 or older, while there are 68,962 here.



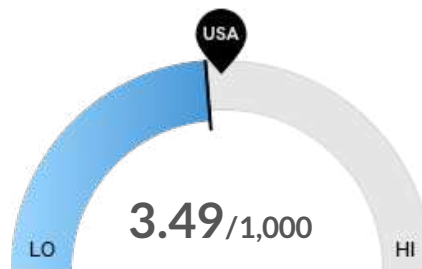
**Racial Diversity**

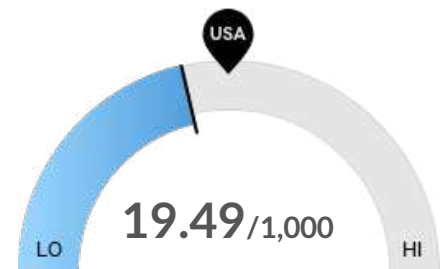

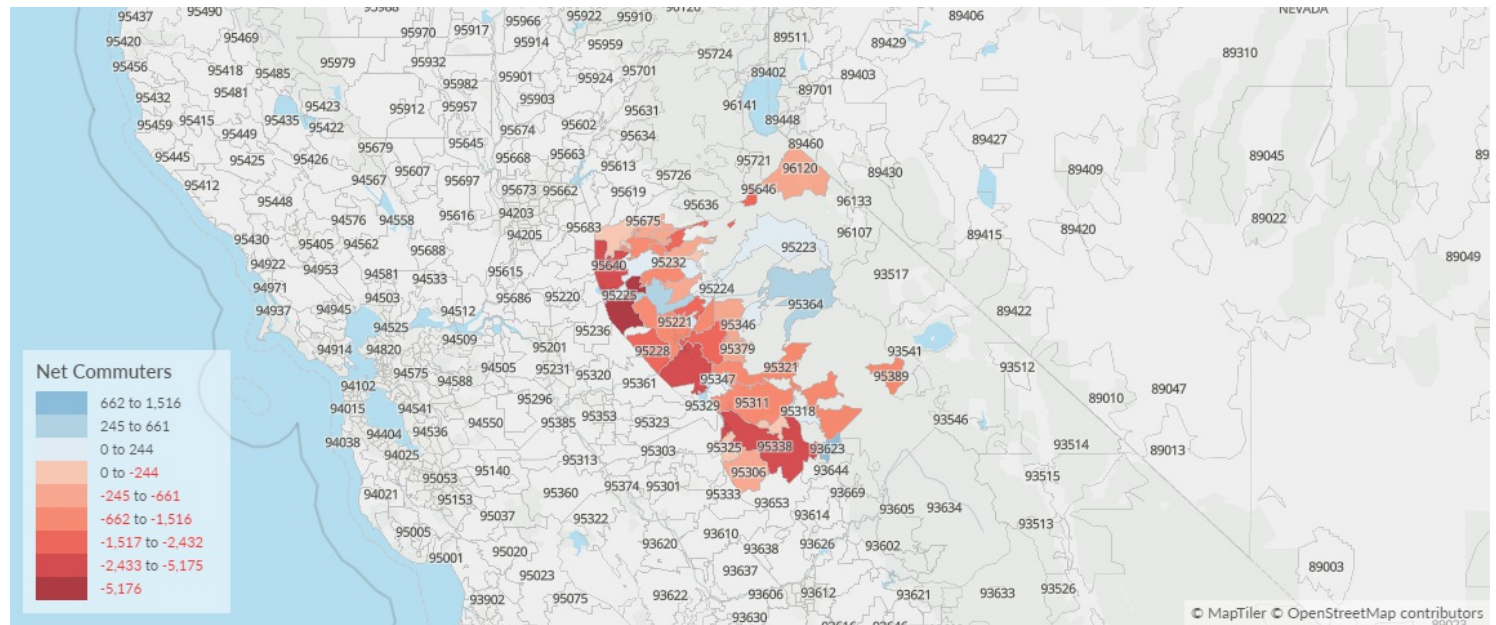

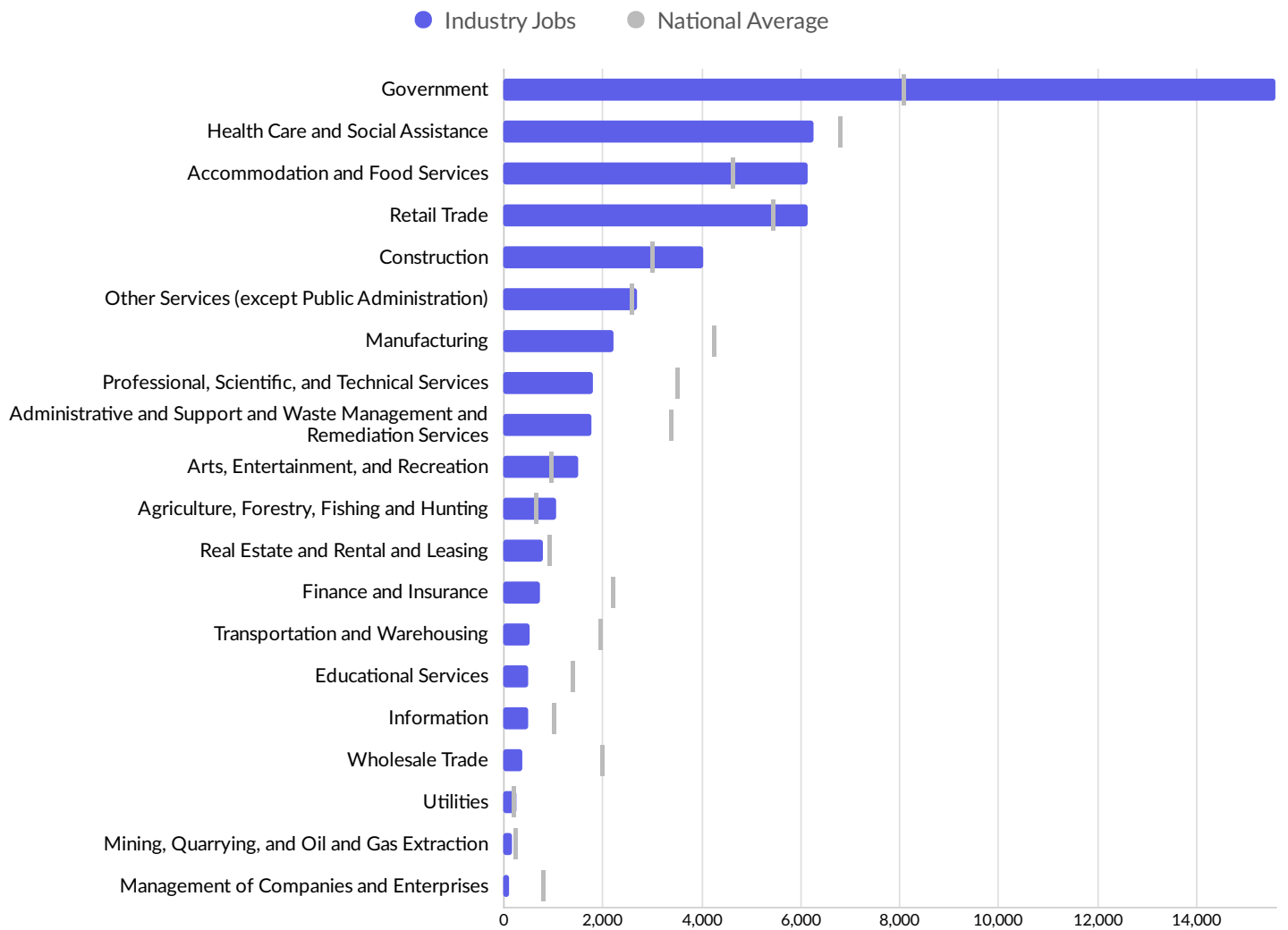

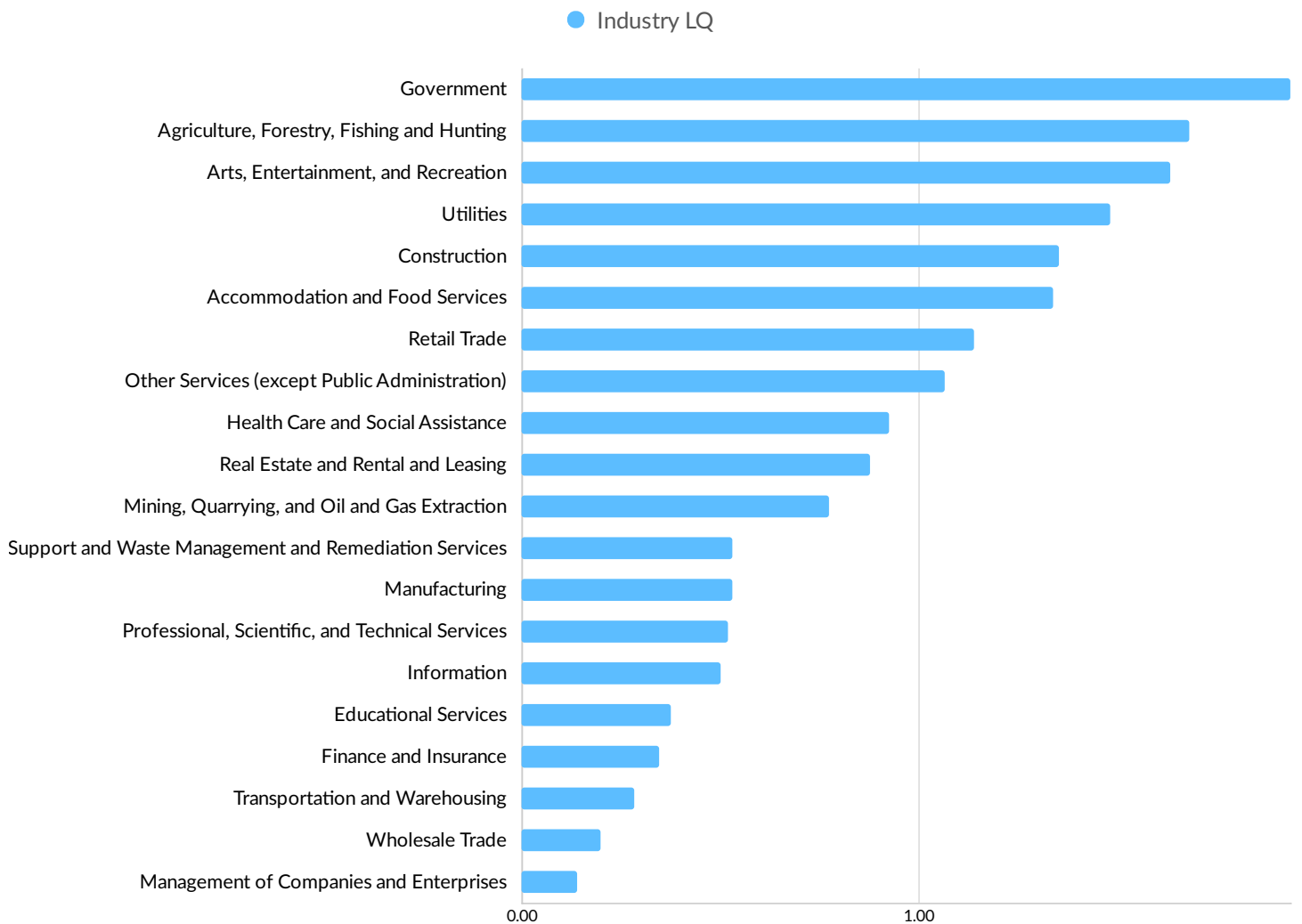

### Top Growing Industries



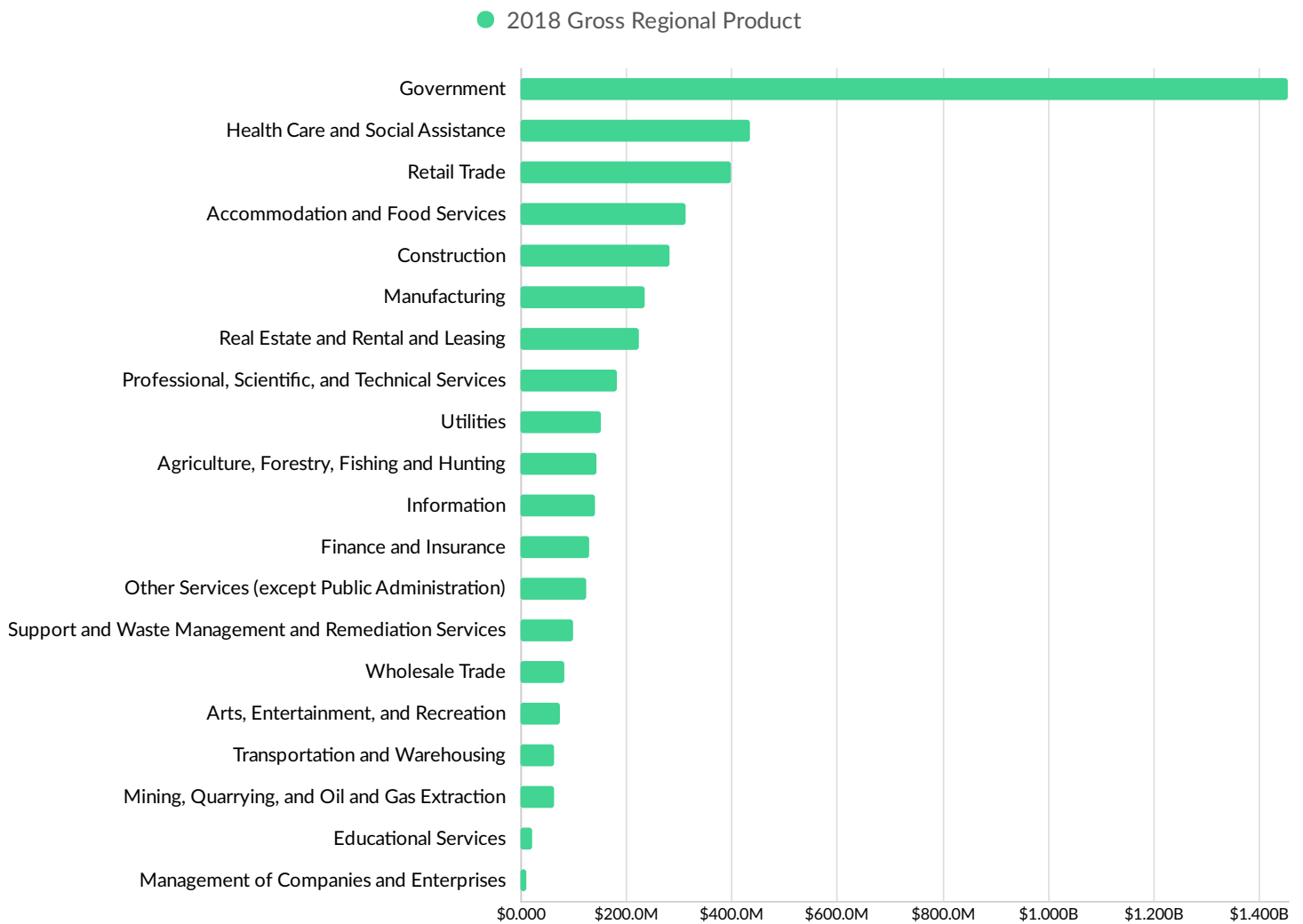

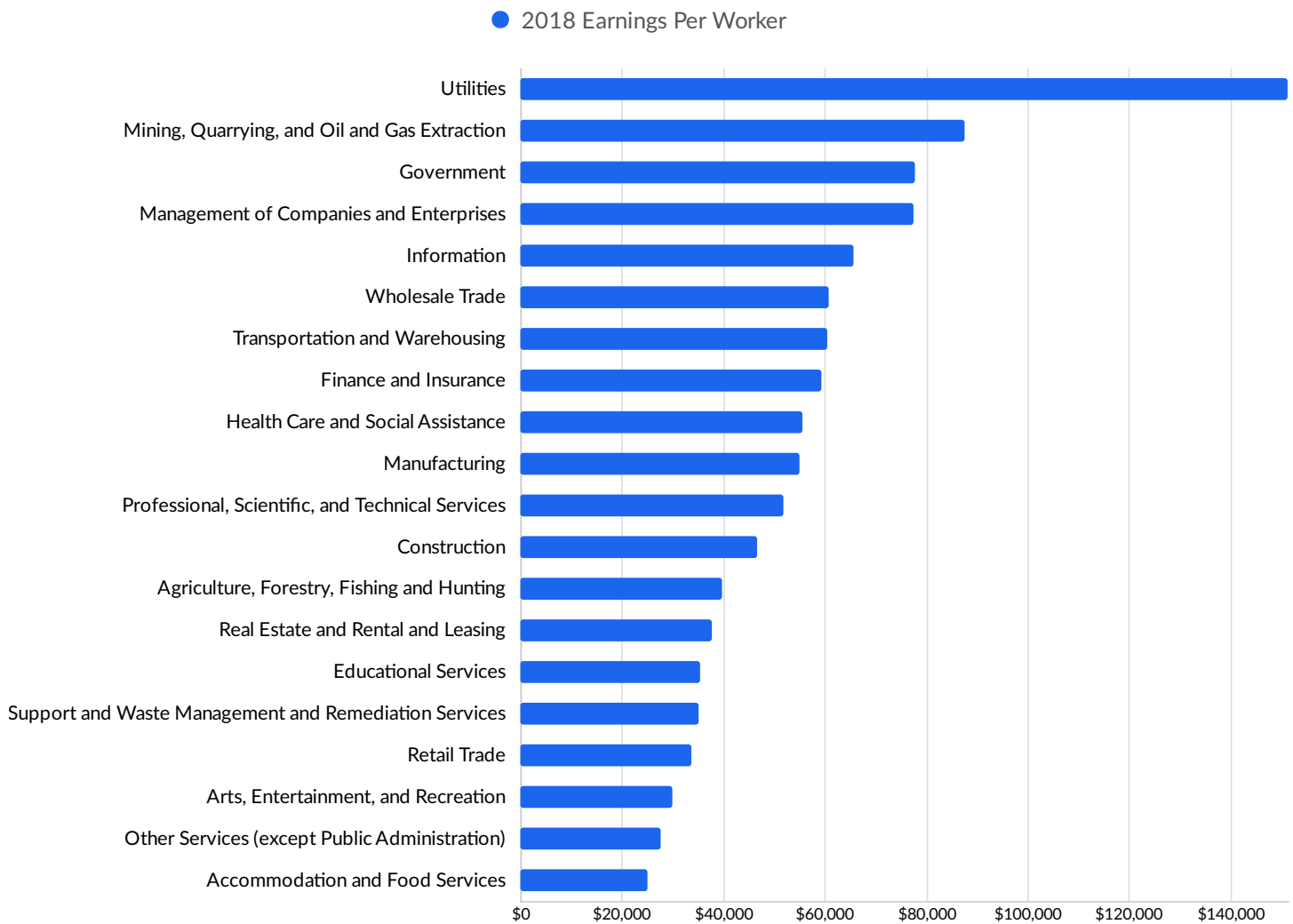

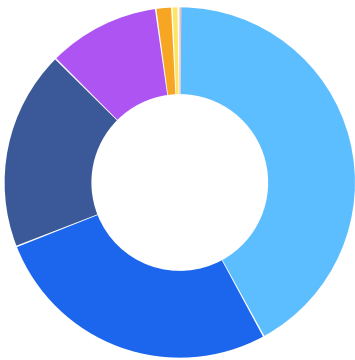

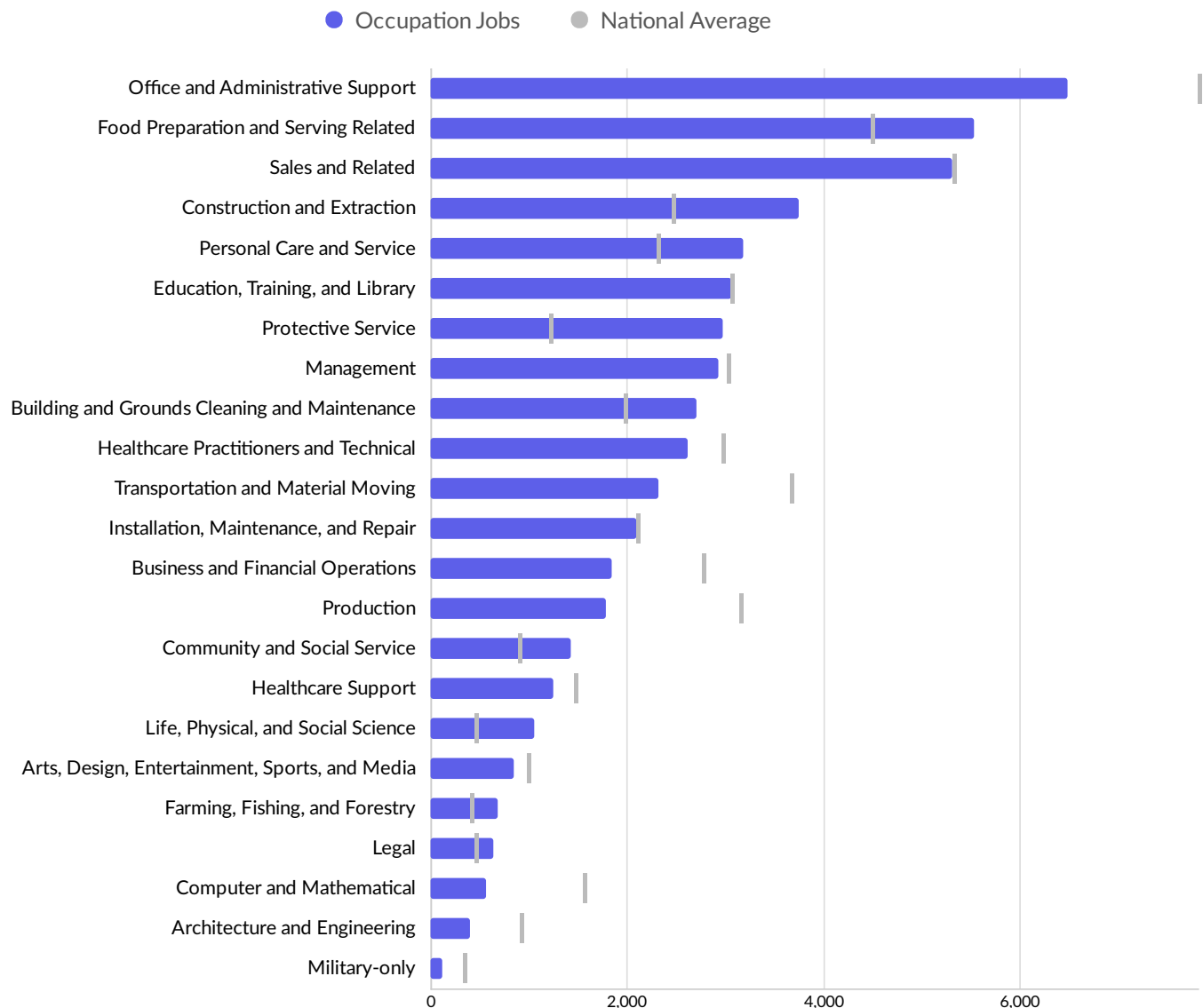

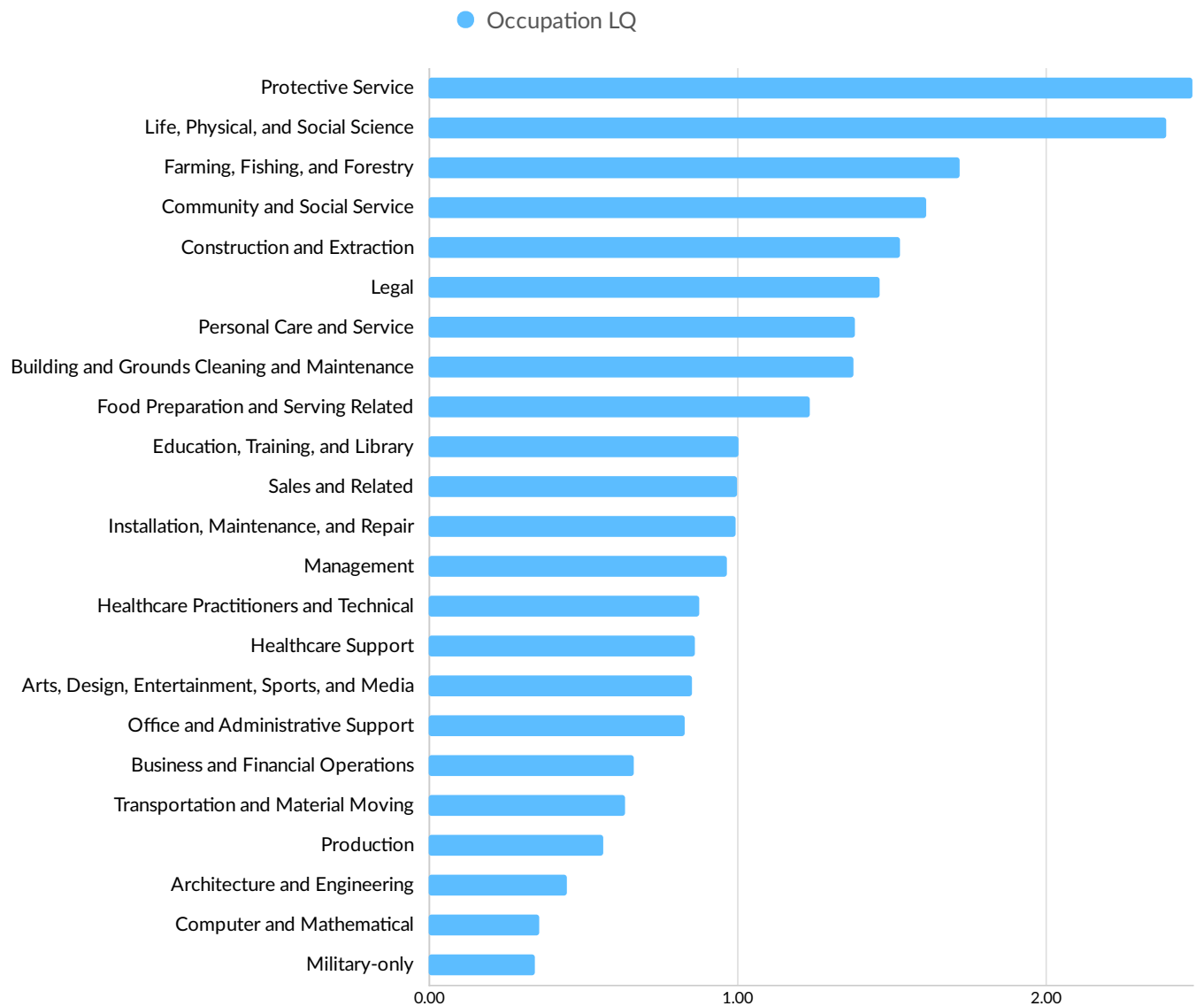

### Top Growing Occupations



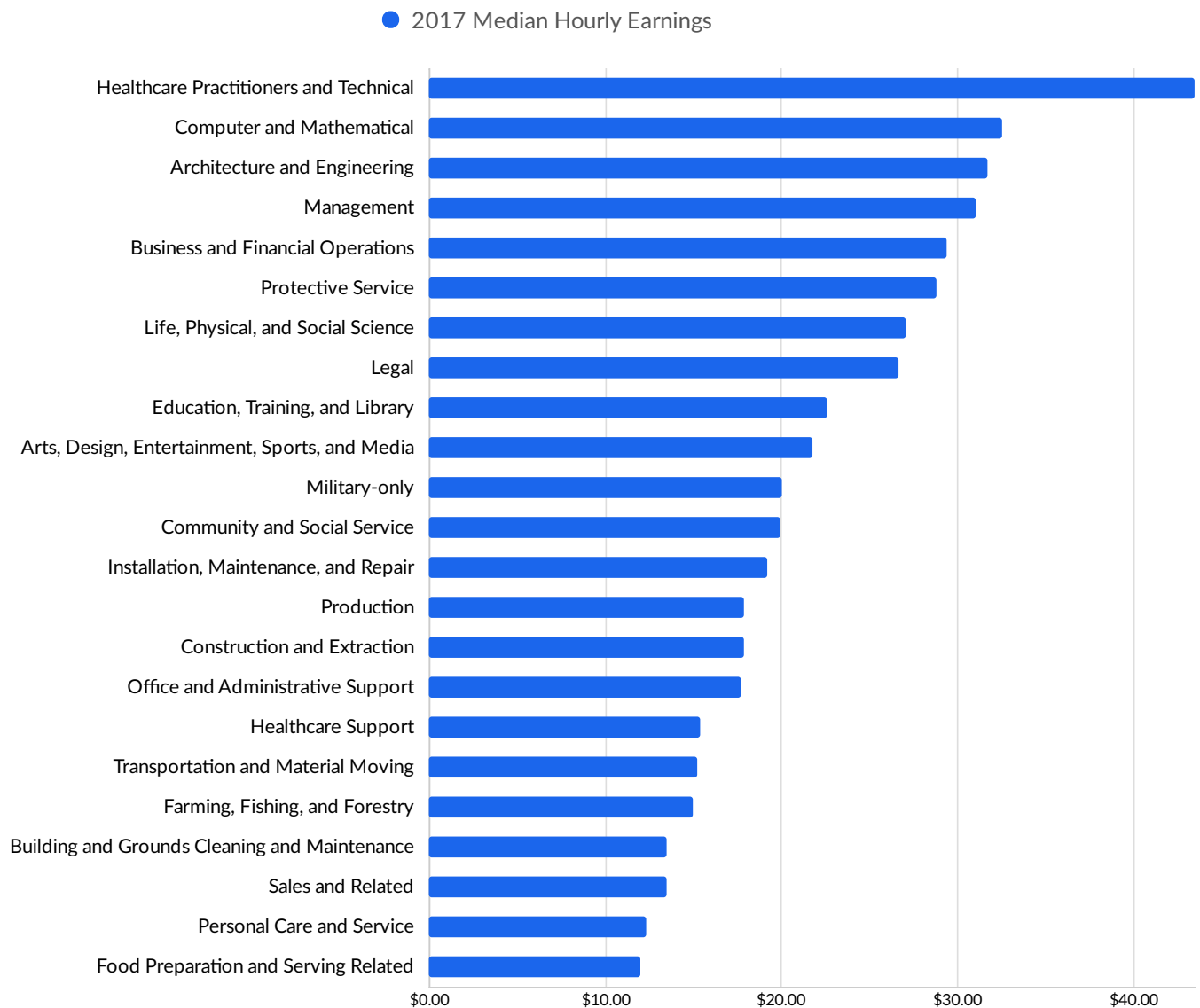

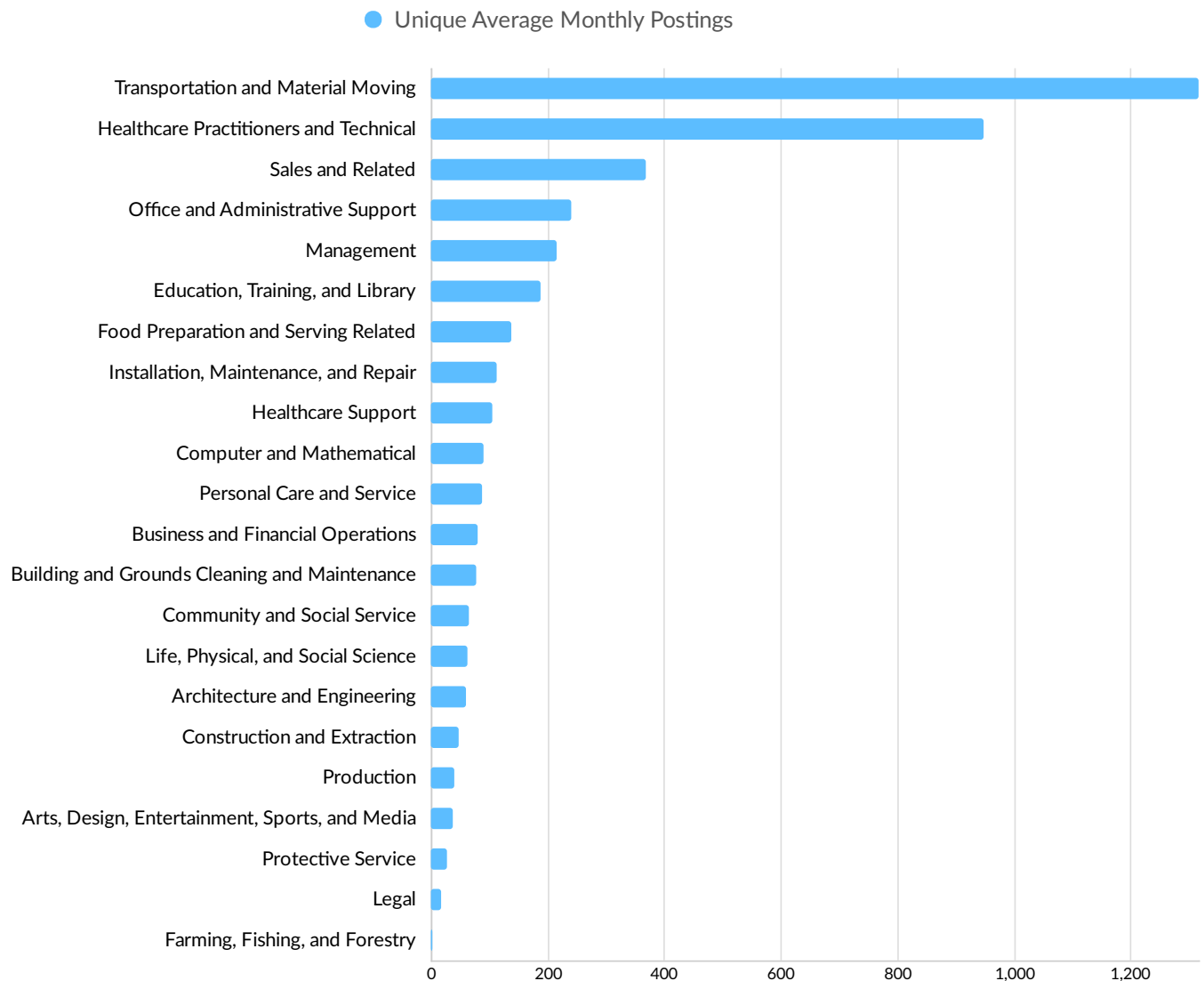

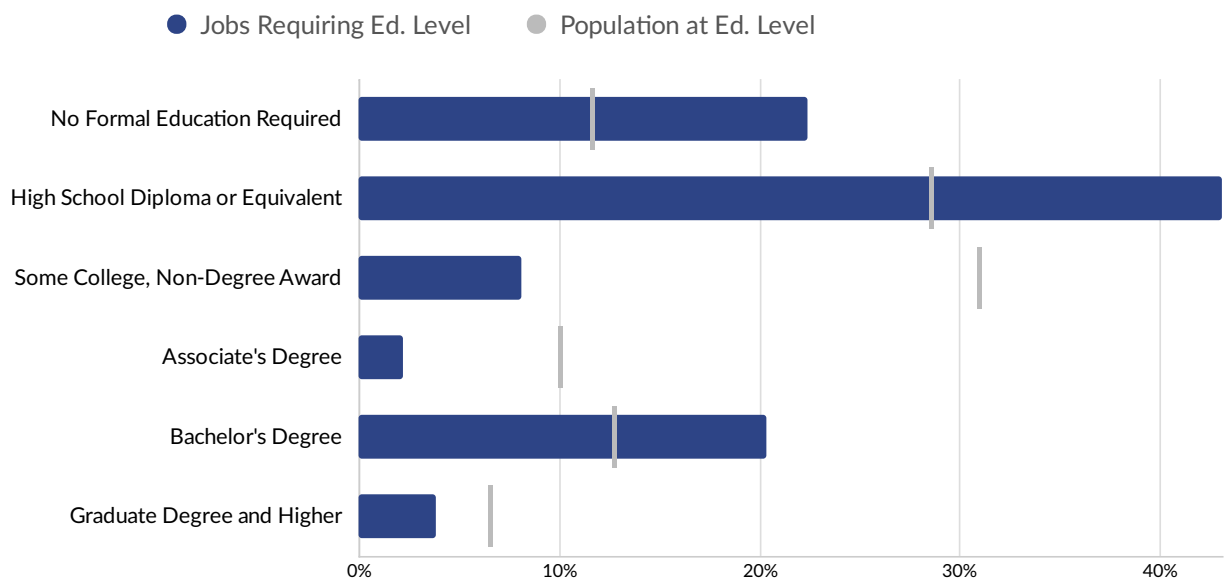
